Introduction

The Governors at Holy Trinity Lamorbey have agreed the following policy on School Uniform. All children who attend the school will be expected to wear uniform in the school colours of grey and maroon. At Holy Trinity Lamorbey we encourage children to be tidy and take pride in their appearance and their school.

There is an expectation that children are dressed smartly.

The Foundation Stage

Winter

White polo shirt.

Plain maroon jogging bottoms. Plain maroon sweatshirt, black trainers

Summer

White polo shirt and maroon shorts, black trainers

Key stage One and Two

Winter

Grey trousers

Grey pinafore dress

Grey skirt

White or grey shirt or blouse, long or short sleeved

Maroon and gold striped tie.

Maroon jumper with optional addition of school logo

Children can also wear a maroon blazer with school logo embroidered on the breast pocket

Summer

Girls - may wear pink and white small check gingham dresses

Boys - may wear grey, school uniform type shorts & short sleeved shirt

Outdoor Wear

Plain navy, maroon, grey or black coats.

Please note that Governors strongly recommend that children wear reflective body and/or arm bands on their outdoor clothing so they can be seen clearly by road users.

Optional

Caps, 'college' type scarves and woollen hats in the school colours. Pupils may also wear a straw boater hat with maroon ribbon.

Footwear

Smart, flat heeled black shoes. Trainers and sports shoes are not permitted except as outlined below.

PE Kit

Your child will need a PE Kit, which should consist of dark trainers for outdoor use, white 'polo' sports shirt or in Key Stage 2 only, a maroon and gold sports shirt (rugby type shirt), maroon shorts, plain maroon jogging bottoms, plain maroon sweatshirt, maroon waterproof jacket.

Optional Key Stage 2 – Black Track Suit with Holy Trinity Lamorbey Logo

PLEASE NOTE: Kit should be worn for all P.E. activities as a matter of routine including any early morning or after school coached activities. Feet should be bare for all indoor PE except where a medical condition makes footwear necessary.

Swimming

Plain trunks, swimming shorts or plain coloured one-piece costume. All children are required by the swimming pool authorities to wear a swimming hat.

A drawstring bag is required for the safekeeping of PE Kit. Please make sure this is also clearly named.

The provision of an old shirt is also requested to protect clothing when doing Art and Craft Work.

Hair

Long hair must be tied back. Hair should not be 'sculptured' e.g. 'Nike flicks'.

Jewellery

Jewellery, especially earrings, can be dangerous in primary school because of the activities that children follow in their play and normal routine. No jewellery apart from a wrist-watch may be worn to school. We ask parents to ensure that children do not wear jewellery to school.

Additional Items

The school operates an aspirational award system which results in some pupils earning the right to wear different items of uniform. These items will be funded by the school and may only be worn by children to whom they have been awarded. As these items are paid for by the school and are in recognition of excellence in school, they can be confiscated from the pupil by a member of the senior leadership team if a pupil's behaviour warrants it. Please see the behaviour policy for more details.

These items include

- Chamber Choir Tie

A gold coloured tie with musical notation awarded for earning a place in the chamber choir

- Half colours

A gold coloured tie with sports symbols awarded to pupils who have represented the school at a sports tournament of any standard or discipline

- Full colours

A plain maroon tie with the school logo embroidered below the knot. Awarded to pupils who, in the opinion of the Head Teacher, have made a significant contribution to the sporting, cultural, spiritual, social or moral life of the school or who have made a significant contribution to their local community or church. This tie will be awarded with a certificate explaining the reason why it has been awarded.
