## **Places for the Children of Key Workers and Those Who Most Need to be in School**

Dear Parents,

You are receiving this letter because you have indicated to us that you are a key worker or because we have agreed with you that because of your child's particular needs it would be most beneficial for them to attend school rather than learning remotely.

I write to confirm that your child has a place and we expect to see them in school according to the attendance pattern you indicated on your form or which has been agreed with Mrs Molloy.

In each year group we have arranged for one teacher (or job share partnership) to work in school supporting your children and the other teacher (or job share partnership) will be working remotely supporting those learning from home. Below I have listed which teacher and which classroom your child should report to on Monday (or their first day of attendance). This group will be the 'bubble' your child stays within throughout this period of closure.

Because of the smaller numbers we are expecting it is not currently necessary for us to stagger the start and end of the school day.

Your child is expected in school to begin the day at 8:55 but they can arrive anytime from 8:40am. The school day ends for your child at 3:20pm

Although we will have many fewer children in school over the next 2 weeks it remains essential that you observe the relevant hygiene and social distancing measures when dropping off and collecting your children. We know that we face a new and more infectious version of COVID-19 and we must work together to keep the infection out of the school and avoid further bubble closures.

Please wear a face covering and maintain a 2m social distance at all times when on the school premises. Do not enter our school under any circumstances if you are displaying the symptoms of COVID-19.

The school kitchen will be open and operational throughout the closure. If your child normally has a school dinner, they can expect one next week as well.

I am sorry to report that Schools Out has informed me that they will not be able to operate during this period of closure. I understand parents enrolled with School's Out have received communication about this already. I have spoken to Linda she has assured me that she is keeping this under review and is looking for a way to make it possible for her to open.



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Children who are attending school will not need complete learning on Google Classroom as well. Teachers in school will be covering the same content as what is being put up on Google Classroom for the children at home. If your child is not attending every day they are expected to continue with their learning on Google Classroom at home on the days they are with you. It is important that they do this otherwise they will be behind when they come back in.
