Payment and consent

To help cover the cost of the visit, we are asking parents to pay £6 per pupil. Consent for your child to participate in the school trip must also be recorded. Both consent and payment should be made by logging into Pay360. Please pay as soon as possible, but by Monday 24th January at the latest.

Dress Code

Full school uniform must be worn. It is important that children are reminded of our behaviour expectations whilst representing Holy Trinity Lamorbey in public. It will be cold so please make sure your child is dressed appropriately.

Lunch

As it's an all-day trip, all children will be provided with a packed lunch by the school. If you'd prefer to provide your own lunch, please do so, but no sweets, chocolates or large sharing bags of crisps. Please send your child with a small backpack to carry their lunch and a bottle of water.
