Payment and consent

Due to the ongoing pandemic we ask that only 1 adult per child attend the poetry slam. Please can we ask that you do not purchase refreshments for your child.

We will be travelling by bus. As our children are under 11 years old, it's not compulsory for them to wear masks, nevertheless, if you want to provide your child with one, and some hand sanitiser, then please do so.
