Dear Parents and Carers,

This year we will be holding a Christingle service for the Year One children on **Thursday 9th December at 2:30pm.**

In the morning, the children will learn about the important work of the Children's Society and will make their own Christingles. Below is a brief description of a Christingle taken from the Children's Society;

"The word Christingle means 'Christ light' and we can think of Christingle as the reason for Christmas – Jesus comes as a light into the world. The red ribbon also points us towards Jesus' death and resurrection at Easter.

There are four parts to a Christingle;

- *Orange*
- *Red ribbon or tape*
- *Sticks and fruits*
- *Candle.*

When we put these together, we remember that God is our hope in the world as we seek to bring our communities together in celebrating God's love for us all."

We will make our Christingle in class in the morning and in the afternoon, we would like to invite parents into school to celebrate our Christingle service. Our service will begin at 2:30pm in the school hall so please arrive from 2:15pm.

The children will also be bringing home a small collection candle to collect a small donation in which will go towards the Children's Society charity.
