As your child is now in year 6, there are more opportunities to represent the school and be seen in other schools and venues. It is therefore important that they all look smart and presentable at all times.

These are timetabled from Monday 9th May - Thursday 12th May 2022.

Your child will be working very hard in preparation for these as it is important that they work to their full potential and to the best of their ability so they move to their next school with the best results possible.

Your child will sit: 1 reading test, 1 SPAG paper, 1 Spelling test and 3 maths papers. These are spread out across the week - there are no tests on the Friday.

Please take a year 6 handout. This provides some information about what will be required from the children at the end of the year.
