Introduction

We strongly encourage schools to have a uniform as it can play a key role in:

- ✓ promoting the ethos of a school
- ✓ providing a sense of belonging and identity
- ✓ setting an appropriate tone for education

Complying with the school uniform is one of the minimum behaviours set out in our expectations at the point that parents enroll their children at Holy Trinity Lamorbey CE Primary. We are very proud of how our pupils present themselves. Our uniform is very smart and practical, and it reflects what we think of ourselves and our Academy. Please could we ask that <u>ALL</u> uniform items are <u>clearly marked with your child's name</u>.

The Foundation Stage

Winter

White polo shirt.
Plain maroon jogging bottoms.
Plain maroon sweatshirt.
Black trainers/shoes

Summer

White polo shirt and maroon shorts, black trainers

Key Stages One and Two

Winter options:

Grey trousers Grey pinafore dress

Grey skirt

White or grey shirt or blouse, long or short sleeved

Maroon and gold striped tie (Year 6 are expected to be able to tie a tie independently)

Maroon jumper or cardigan with optional addition of school logo

Children can also wear a maroon blazer with school logo embroidered on the breast pocket

Summer options:

Pink and white small check gingham dresses Grey, school uniform type shorts Short sleeved shirt (with tie) White polo shirt

Outdoor Wear

Plain waterproof coats.

Please note that we strongly recommend that children wear reflective body and/or arm bands on their outdoor clothing so they can be seen clearly by road users.

Optional: Caps, scarves and woolen hats - preferably in the school colours.

Footwear

Smart, flat-heeled black shoes. Trainers and sports shoes are not permitted except as outlined below. Pupils must have different footwear for normal school use and PE.

PE Kit

Your child will need a PE Kit to school on the days they do PE. Options include:

- Plain black or plain white trainers for outdoor use
- white 'polo' sports shirt or plain white t-shirt (logo optional)
- plain maroon, black or grey shorts
- plain maroon, black or grey jogging bottoms
- plain maroon sweatshirt

PLEASE NOTE: Kit should be worn for all P.E. activities as a matter of routine including any early morning or after school coached activities. Feet should be bare for all indoor PE except where a medical condition makes footwear necessary.

ANY/ALL small studded earrings must be easily removable <u>independently</u> by the child for ALL PE sessions.

Swimming

Plain trunks, swimming shorts or plain coloured one-piece costume. All children are required by the swimming pool authorities to wear a swimming hat.

The provision of an old shirt is also requested to protect clothing when doing Art and Craft Work. This will be announced closer to the activity time.

Hair

Long hair must be tied back with plain/small hairband. Large bows, etc. are not needed and may be removed. Hair should not be 'sculptured' e.g. 'Nike flicks'. We are proud to adopt <u>The Halo Code</u>.



Jewellery

Jewellery can be dangerous in primary school because of the activities that children follow in their play and normal routine. We ask parents to ensure that children do not wear jewellery to school. Small studded earrings are accepted, only if the child can remove them independently. These items will be the sole responsibility of the pupil once removed.

Watches

Watches are only permitted for pupils in Year 5 and 6. They must not be 'smart' style watches or have any access to social media, tracking, etc.

Suppliers

Uniforms can be bought from: Casey's Schoolwear, 246 Blackfen Rd, Sidcup, DA15 8PW. 'Pre-loved' uniform sales happen regularly throughout the school year and are run by the Holy Trinity Lamorbey PTA.

Please note that it is not compulsory to purchase logo items from school, you may purchase plain uniform items from a shop of your choice - something that we actively encourage you to do.
