## Pupil Premium

Did you know that you may be entitled for help towards the cost of school trips, uniform and after school clubs, along with supermarket vouchers issued during the school holidays to help with the cost of meals?

These vouchers are currently issued by Bexley/Bromley Council not the school.

Your child may be eligible for Pupil Premium funding if you receive any of the following:

- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The guaranteed element of Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit (provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190)
- Working Tax Credit run-on – the payment someone may receive for a further four weeks after they stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit.
- Universal Credit – you must annually take home £7,400 or less in Universal Credit payments.

This equals an average of £616.67 per month in net earned income (after deductions)

You are not eligible for this funding if you receive Working Tax Credit or other support payments that are not mentioned above.

This money is also used to help support your child's learning and funding is available to all children from Reception through to Year 6.

We are able to check if you are eligible, please complete the permission slip below and return to the school/trust.

Upon checking we will inform you of the outcome.
